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CHILDREN THRIVING THROUGH OUR SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM

A young oak that had been uprooted is steadily gaining roots by a fresh water stream. Fabian Semukaaya was born in the absence of his dad who had abandoned his expectant wife after entering an illicit relationship with a woman indulged in drugs, alcoholism and witchcraft. Five months before his birth. Fabian's dad had deteriorated in conduct as he ceased going to work as a builder but turned violent

to his Fabian's mum. "Life as a single mother with three children and no job and no home drove me to resort selling spirits and beers to get food for my children and rent a l roomed house." Pauline. Fabian's mum confessed. Pauline heard Kisima Junior School director shar-

ing about God's heart for children at a local Anglican church where she had run for help in February 2018. God has transformed this family's life especially their only son Fabian who is in school thanks to the generous families supporting our child sponsorship. Fabian loves football and works hard at school with friends in preparing vegetable gardens. He once shared, 'when I grow up I want to help my mum and sisters to build them a big house and plant enough food for them." Fabian needs a safe comtians to nurture and mentor him to overcome the

munity of loving Chrisstigma he and his siblings faced and rejection they experienced when their dad abandoned them.

Through his local Prayer covenant club, Fabian and 57 other children pray together for each other's needs.

Our sponsored children receive regular discipleship, pray with an adult and their families receive monitoring visits to ensure they are using the skills acquired to do gainful work.

Transformation in a Local Church—All Saints' Church Mutundwe



Everyday we are experiencing God relentlessly empowering the local church to reach out and nurture young people. One of these churches is All Saints' Church Mutundwe located south of Kampa-

la. Through an ongoing partnership, we have in real time served with this congregation to bring back the agenda of discipling young people to top the priorities among her families. The vicar Rev. Kisaakye and his dear wife grasped God's vision for children through a very personal encounter that fundamentally changed their view of the place of children in mission. As Mrs. Kisaakye narrated during a Sunday service to climax our holiday ministry in this church; the Christian parents have delegated the responsibility of raising children to schools and other institutions where children spend most of

their time.

During our Saturday conference, children and youths shared the struggles they face in relationships and interaction with media. Our teaching on building Christ honoring relationships highlighted the principles in scripture to building healthy relationships. An open discussion was held on Sunday in the presence of children, youth and their parents to clearly communicate the needs of young people and the roles of the adults as role models, mentors and spiritual guides.

This church has established a youth service every Sunday and gives opportunity to youth to minister one Sunday every month. What can your church do?

Our Farming God's Way Story

Having successfully tested for 8 months our gardens with organic vegetable growing, we are ready to scale up the school farm project. We are particularly thankful to God for the Farming God's way model which seeks to maximise on environmentally friendly farming practices that enhance soil fertility while harvesting chemical-free products. Using hoes, our students and ground workers prepare the soils taking out weed grass which is later returned to the garden after drying it in the

Through the Farmers' Club, children are planting one acre of mixed vegatables and greens to be harvested one month to 4



months from now. 17 groups of children are receiving seeds to do plant gardens of 30 by 20 feet in their homes for demonstration and pro-

vision of vegetables. We have invested \$298 into purchase of seeds and farm tools plus another \$80 per month for our farm manager. In 4 months our I acre has capacity to produce over \$1,500 worth of vegetables and corn which will feed children for two school terms.

We have received an offer of I.5 acres of farm land 300 metres from the school being sold at \$2,000. If we acquired this piece, we would ultimately expand the school farm to increase food security, ensure a balanced diet. We are shifting from spending thousands of dollars on food purchases to growing our own food! Our plan to establish a poultry, piggery and cattle keeping projects need this piece of land which will be fenced off a safe distance away from school. We make organic manure from cow, chicken and pig droppings. After sun drying them, we put them in an air-tight 100 litre tank which we covered for 2 weeks. We also cover grass in dump environment for it to decompose into manure.



CONSTRUCTION



We completed brick-work for the building to house Hope clinic/sick bay for our children at Kisima Junior school. now awaiting roofing, plastering walls, pouring floor concrete and installing doors and windows.

We installed a window and door on our

store room at the main classroom block. Remaining with 14 windows and 4 doors to secure classroom block.

We completed concrete slab and foundation for pit latrine at the site for teachers' houses. We have 14,000 bricks, and stones but in need of 100 bags of cement, iron bars and sand to start construction work.
